Position Summary

The Senior Manager of Scientific Affairs will be responsible for analysis, interpretation, and communication of Global Scientific Evidence. The Senior Manager will work closely with Key Opinion Leaders to understand their ideas for scientific presentations and publications, translate those ideas to statisticians for analysis, interpret and communicate results. The individual should have strong medical writing skills with the ability to convey difficult concepts clearly.

The position requires high attention to detail with the ability to think strategically. Effective KOL engagement and publication development and dissemination will enable clinical evidence for the therapy to be efficiently disseminated to the scientific community.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Key team member in developing and disseminating scientific publications.
- Assist in the development of and/or co-authoring of clinical abstracts and manuscripts for professional meetings, societies, or journals.
- Communicate with Key Opinion Leaders regarding ideas for data analysis.
- Work closely with statisticians to analyze and interpret clinical study data.
- Ability to initiate analyses and interpret data tables and listings independently.
- Distill complicated scientific concepts into clear messages for internal and external stakeholders.
- Review and summarize relevant literature published in the field.
- Active influencer to the corporation relating to clinical trial strategy and scientific data generation.
- Lead the development of tools for speakers seeking to communicate key ReCor clinical trial results.
- Provide education for clinical centers and field personnel on clinical study data.

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- Lead working groups of physicians focused on topics of interest.
- Manage publication process to ensure meeting company's goals related to evidence dissemination.
- Support communication with regulatory agencies regarding clinical data.
